The main aims of this workshop are to improve the extent to which the current (2019) ESC/EAS guidelines for the management of dyslipidaemia are understood and implemented by healthcare professionals and to address the local challenges & knowledge gaps that result in sub-optimal implementation through education and practical training of practicing clinicians. 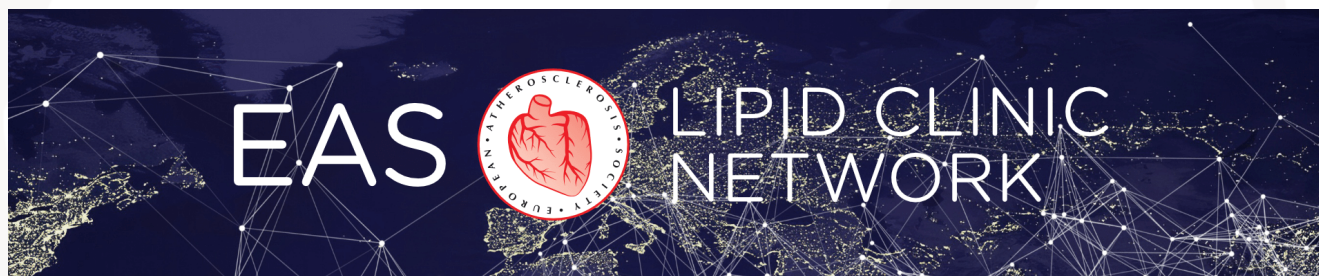
